Breakfast at hotel. Visit the Palmach Museum, an interactive museum displaying the legacy of the Elite striking force of the Haganah and Israel battle for Independence.

Enjoy a one-time experience of lunch and story in the private home of Doris Haifai, located in Ajami neighborhood, Jaffa Visit Peres Center for Peace and Innovation; the center, founded by Nobel Peace Laureate and former President of Israel Shimon Peres, explores Shimon Peres' vision for Peace in the Middle East and Israel as a leading start-up nation.

Proceed to the Dead Sea, lowest place on earth.

Havdalah service overlooking the Dead Sea.

Optional evening activities on your own: Spa treatments, local mall or walk along the sea.

Dinner and Overnight: Nevo Hotel, Dead Sea



Breakfast at hotel. Free morning to enjoy a dip in the Dead Sea, hotel and spa facilities.

Drive via the Negev Desert to Mamshit Ranch for a Camel tour of the Negev mountains.

Proceed to Sde Boker, view David Ben Gurion's grave site overlooking Zin stream.

Monday, February 19: Mitzpe Ramon

Breakfast at hotel. Drive to Mitzpe Ramon. Introduction to the desert at Ramon visitor center; learn about Ilan Ramon space heritage and the formation of the Machtesh. Jeep tour of Machtesh Ramon.

Visit Nana Farm: meet today's pioneers and see how David Ben Gurion's vision materialized into reality.

Afternoon tea and coffee at a Bedouin tent.

Dinner and Overnight: Kedma Hotel, Sde Boker










Tuesday, February 20: Life on the Border Line - Jerusalem

Breakfast at hotel. Depart Kedma to Ashalim to discover the secrets of desert agriculture at Ramat Negev Agriculture Research and Development Center.

Proceed to the "Gaza Surrounds". Visit Path to Peace at Kibbut Nativ Ha'asara; Setting mosaic stones on the border wall between Israel and the Gaza Strip followed by tour of the Moshav, conversation and lunch.

Drive to Jerusalem. Shehechyanu ceremony overlooking the "Golden City'.

Overnight: Orient Hotel, Jerusalem



Breakfast at hotel. Visit Yad Lakashish; Lifeline for the Elderly. Today we experience the thrill of entering the Old City.

Visit the newly renovated Davidson Center for an audio-visual visit to Beit Hamikdash. See Southern Wall excavations. Walk to the Western Wall and have first visit at the Kotel. Guided tour of the Kotel Tunnels, the underground continuation of the Western Wall, along the Temple Mount.

Continue via the Arab Shuk and the Roman Cardo – the "Ancient Mall" of the Old City, to the Jewish Quarter.

Lunch on your own and free time in the Jewish Quarter. Visit the Hurva synagogue including old city overlook.

Friday, February 23: New City of Jerusalem


